Karl was a member of the Guild for 46 years, 40 years as a member of the Board.

In 2021 The Guilds Foundation was able to pay out 60.000 kr. to many good purposes.

Due to meeting restrictions, we held a meeting with three representatives from the recipients in "Laugslokalet", where we handed over the donations. The representatives were: Salvation Army, Goldschmidt's Music Academy and Aalborg Pensionistorkester



Karl was the last member of the Board, who was active in the resistance movement, during the second world war. Karl was arrested by gestapo and spent the last 6 month of the war in the KZ Camp Neuengamme.

We in the Board will miss Karl and his good humor and remember him with great pleasure.
